







	Art. no.	Description	Areas of Application
	VH320R	Short blade, finely serrated 160 mm, 6 1/4"	For ears, transitions, fine detail work, head and cheek area, neck and tail
	VH321R	Very finely serrated 195 mm, 7 3/4"	Suitable for spaniels/setters
	VH325R	English model 180 mm, 7"	Westies, wire-haired daschunds and other terriers with normal or little undercoat
	VH326R	Very finely serrated 180 mm, 7"	For finishing work, trimming individual upright hairs on top coat, also suitable for ears/neck and head area where hair is kept very short
	VH327R	Finely serrated 190 mm, 7 1/2"	For fine hair, normal to thicker undercoats, for areas that need to be trimmed very short with great precision, for undercoats
	VH328R	Medium serration 190 mm, 7 1/2"	For normal coats with a proportionate undercoat, for terrier "jackets", backs and sides (Westie, Fox, Scottish, Airdale, Lakeland, Schnauzer), also suitable for thicker undercoats
	VH329R	Wide serrations 190 mm, 7 1/2"	For coarse and heavy top coat with undercoat element (Airedale, Fox, Scottish, Welsh), suitable for all terriers and schnauzers, for back/jacket area + trunk
	MC Clellan VH333R	Finely serrated 145 mm, 5 3/4"	Castrated dogs (following coat change on castrated dogs), for dense undercoats, for Cocker Spaniels and Setters with dense undercoats or plush coats, for dogs with stock-haar-type coats, for removing loose, dead fur from Alsations, Labradors, and so on.
	MC Clellan VH334R	Wide serrations 145 mm, 5 3/4"	Trimming dogs with coarse coats with little or no waves or curls, with normal or little undercoat (for example, Wire-Hair Dachshund, Border Terrier, Parson Jack Russell, and so on)
